

Project Background

- 1999 Terrace Improvements
Reconstruction of east terrace, planters, ramps, stairs, etc.
- 2008 Phase I, Rundel Structural Repairs
Rundel building substructure & perimeter
- 2010 Phase II, Rundel Structural Repairs
Preliminary high priority structural repairs under Loading dock, Court Street Terrace, and East Terrace.
- 2013 Phase III, Rundel Structural Repairs
Court Street Terrace & Loading Dock
Waterproofing and Reconstruction including new top slab, pavers, drainage system, etc.
- 2016 Broad Street Bridge
Preventative Maintenance
- 2017-2019 Phase IV, Rundel Structural Terrace Improvements
Full structural inspections and repairs/ reconstruction of the elevated East Sidewalk and North Terrace

Project Location



Project Objectives

- Evaluate the existing conditions of the entire structural substructure.
- Assess the integrity of previous repairs.
- Identify priority repairs for immediate and future execution to extend the serviceable life and preserve the character and integrity of this vital center city infrastructure.
- Develop a site specific Master Plan and, if necessary, a plan for phased strategic implementation.

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





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PROJECT TIMELINE

- JUNE 2017** In-Depth structural Site Investigation
- JULY 2017** Emergency closure of three location on the North Terrace and East (South Ave.) Sidewalk
- JULY - AUGUST 2017** Temporary shoring installed to support cantilevered sidewalk along Broad Street and Location below East (South Ave.) sidewalk.
- AUGUST - SEPTEMBER 2017** Temporary fencing installed closing entire North Terrace
- OCTOBER 2017 - DECEMBER 2018** Design of North Terrace and East Sidewalk Structural Repairs/Reconstruction



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
STRUCTURAL WORK ITEMS OVER TUNNEL

EAST SIDEWALK (SOUTH AVE.)

- Remove East Sidewalk Concrete Slab
- Infill areaway below east sidewalk OR install new elevated slab for east sidewalk
- Install new landscape features

NORTH TERRACE

- Remove existing north terrace concrete slab
- Remove existing north terrace steel framing
- Replace north terrace framing
- Replace north terrace concrete slab
- Install new landscape features






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1936-1937 North Terrace
 Newspaper articles note that the bids for the terrace construction were excessive and the project was rebid and constructed between 1936-37.




1936 Rundel Library
 Designed and built during the Great Depression, the Rundel Memorial Building is constructed over the Johnson Seymour Mill Race, the old Erie Canal, and Rochester Subway bed. The mill race, which was incorporated into the design of the building, still flows under the building and a portion spills through a series of archways built into the West facade of the building.



1927-1956 Rochester Subway
 Built in the bed of the Erie Canal Aqueduct, construction began in 1921, and in 1927 the Subway was completed, carrying the first passengers under the City.



1925 Broad Street Bridge
 Built on the foundation of the Erie Canal Aqueduct, the Broad Street Bridge provided an important link between the east and west during the rise of the automobile.



1842-1919 Erie Canal Aqueduct
 Replacing the original aqueduct (circa 1823), a second, wider aqueduct was constructed across the Genesee River to accommodate the increase in Canal traffic. Built entirely of Onondaga Limestone, the second aqueduct provides the foundation for the current Broad Street Bridge.




1817 Johnson - Seymour Mill Race
 The race was cut along the East bank of the Genesee River by Elisha Johnson and Orson Seymour to operate mills on the site of the Rundel Library.




Genesee River
 Flowing through the heart of the City, the River provided the power necessary for its growth.






Lower Level Subway Tracks




Lower Level Subway Tracks and Structures





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
