

Public Consensus	Design Solution
Preserve existing greenspace.	The design keeps close to the existing playground's footprint, ruling out traditional swings, but including swinging elements.
Incorporate the NOTA color palette (black, white, yellow) and progressive design.	These colors can be incorporated into the "Modern City" play equipment line.
Include benches and picnic tables.	These items are incorporated into the design.
Incorporate a variety of options for play, including hanging, climbing, sliding, and traveling	These features are incorporated into the design.
Include toddler play equipment.	Toddler play equipment is included in the design.
Minimize use of asphalt.	Only a short asphalt path and pad is required to provide ADA accessibility to the play equipment.




