PUBLIC HEARING TO TAKE PLACE ON MIDTOWN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT
DRAFT GENERIC ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT

(Rochester, New York) —The public hearing on the City’s Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement (DGEIS) for the Midtown Rising development project will take place 6:30 p.m., Tue., Dec. 2 at City Council Chambers, City Hall, 30 Church St. The Rochester Environmental Commission will conduct the hearing, which will feature a short overview of the document by Labella Associates P.C., followed by a public comment period.

In accordance with the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), the DGEIS, a document describing and analyzing redevelopment alternatives and impacts for the Midtown site, is subjected to a 40-day period for public review, which officially commenced Monday, Nov. 10 and will conclude on Friday, December 19. Advance registration is not necessary to speak at the hearing. A Final Generic Environmental Impact Statement will be issued in February 2009 and will address the substantive questions and comments raised at the hearing.
