

## Public Information Meeting Minutes

RE: **Stutson Street Improvement Project**  
(Lake Avenue to River Street)  
PC 05125  
Date: June 12, 2012 7:00 P.M.  
Location: Lakeside Presbyterian Church, 75 Stutson Street  
Attendees: See attached.

Rich Koss opened the meeting by welcoming the attendees and introducing himself.

Attached is the agenda/informational flyer handed out at the meeting.

Rich gave a general outline of the project and construction schedule. Under present transportation funding, the project will include pavement milling and resurfacing with installation of new curbs, sidewalk replacement, driveway aprons, water main, water services, catch basins, and hydrants. The pavement width will remain the same.

Also discussed was the scope of work to be done using the New York State Economic Development \$300,000 grant for enhancements. This scope is to salvage brick cubes and use them for highlights in the sidewalk, and enhanced lighting fixtures on Stutson Street (Lake Av to River St.), River Street (bridge to St John's Park), Ellis Place, Petten Street and Lakeport Street.

The issue of on street parking was discussed. Sector 1 leader Glen Gardener had previously met with the residents concerning this topic. Rich stated that more attractive streets lights would cost an additional approx. \$35,000 and a reconstructed brick pavement would cost approximately \$250,000.

The general consensus among the attendees was in favor of more attractive streets and brick pavement but only if a grant would pay the additional costs.

Rich suggested an "curb only" project for the present time with pavement improvements only after possible grants were researched..

Proposed parking restrictions was also discussed, with the general consensus being that on parking should be allowed in front of the churches and business and alternate side parking be allowed in the residential area.

There will be one more Public Information Meeting prior to construction.
