- Benefits of the Project
 - Supports the overall Midtown project through the construction of a new building.


- Benefits of the Project
 - Tax Revenue
 - \$22 million over 20 years

- Benefits of the Project
 - Total investment: \$55 million
 - Construction investment: \$39
 million
 - Peak construction jobs estimated at 220

- PAETEC Commitment
 - Constructing a building
 - Bringing and creating jobs
 - Borrowing \$34 million
 - \$5 million of their own equity
 - Paying for and occupying for 20 years

- PAETEC Commitment
 - Paying their share of maintenance and operation of the garage
 - \$30 per pass, escalating to \$44 per pass over 20 years
 - Paid by PAETEC, not their employees

- Public Support
 - City provides land
 - City provides a portion of the Seneca Building superstructure and site preparation totaling \$1.5 million
 - City arranges for \$16.5 million Section 108 federal loan
 - \$9 million in grants from a combination of sources tied to maintaining and increasing employment
