**Project Name:** NYS REDI Grants - West Side  
**Location:** West side of Genesee River – approximately 2,800 feet from the foot of Petten Street in the south to former CSX Swing Bridge embankment in the north.  
**Applicant:** City of Rochester - DES/A&E  
**Project Description:** The proposed actions include the extension of existing shoreline stabilization methods, installation of new shoreline flood protection measures, and modifications to existing docks. Two pump stations will also be installed to convey stormwater to the Genesee River from River Street. This proposed effort will increase resiliency within the project area by reducing flooding potential, riverbank erosion, and property damage caused by high-water events.

**Location:** East side of Genesee River – approximately 975 feet from the northern limits of the Rochester Yacht Club in the south to and including the US Coast Guard Station in the north.

**Project Description:** The proposed actions include extension of existing flood protection measures, installation of new flood protection measures, improvements to the Summerville Wastewater Pumping Station (WWPS) and modifications to the Public Storm Sewer System. This project will increase resiliency within the project area by reducing flooding, riverbank erosion, and property damage caused by high-water events.
