



COUNCIL CALLS FOR INVESTIGATION OF MONROE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY

All nine members of the Rochester City Council today signed a letter to NY State Attorney General Letitia James calling for an investigation into the conduct of Monroe County District Attorney Sandra Doorley.

“Recent body camera footage, shared by the Webster Police Department, has raised significant concerns regarding Ms. Doorley’s behavior during a traffic stop in Webster, New York,” the letter reads. “This incident has led us to question her fitness to serve as District Attorney, and we believe an investigation by your office is warranted.”

The letter goes on to explain that as public officials, City Councilmembers and the District Attorney alike are held to the highest standards of ethics, accountability, and respect for the law.

“The behavior exhibited by Ms. Doorley during the traffic stop, as captured in the body camera footage, appears to violate these standards,” the letter reads. “Such behavior undermines the credibility and integrity of our justice system and erodes public trust.”

All nine members of Rochester City Council stand united in their belief that Ms. Doorley’s conduct should be thoroughly investigated by the Attorney General, and that accountability in this matter would demonstrate that no one, regardless of their position, is above the law.

“It is crucial to determine whether her actions during the traffic stop reflect broader issues that could impact the fair administration of justice in Monroe County,” the letter reads.
