Halloween at the Market is a hugely popular event that allows children and families to celebrate Halloween in a safe, fun, interactive environment! At this free event, attendees find the vendor sheds filled with community organizations offering trick-or-treating, activities, performances, entertainment, arts and crafts, and much more--including valuable information about programs and services. This event is for outreach and promotion; no sales of merchandise or services is allowed. There no fee to participate but organizations must turn in this application by Sunday, October 13.

- Participating organizations must be either nonprofit, or serve families/children in some capacity.
- Submit via email at <a href="mailto:PMarket@cityofrochester.gov">PMarket@cityofrochester.gov</a>, or via mail/in person to 280 N. Union St. Rochester 14609. (The Market Office is the 2-story brick building at the center of the market.)
- Application deadline is Friday, October 18. You will receive a response to your application within a week
  after it is received. Other key event details will be sent via email in the coming weeks, and shed/stall
  assignments sent via email to participating organizations by Wednesday, October 23.
- Each organization will receive one 8-foot table, and two folding chairs. Please bring any additional tables/chairs needed. Each organization will be assigned two vendor stalls (10 ft. wide x 30 ft. deep).
   Mark the box below if you need additional space to accommodate your organization.
- Last year, we had 80+ organizations and approximately 5,000 attendees, which makes this an exceptional outreach event for community organizations. Please plan for a large and fast-moving audience! Candy is not necessary for trick-or-treating—stickers, pencils, other small giveaways are great! An activity, performance, or entertainment feature that you can deploy quickly for the families and kids moving through will enable you to get information about your programs and services to the families—and make this event more productive for your organization than just handing out candy! ## **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

Stall(s) are 10' wide X 30' deep, which includes vehicle parking. Stall(s) must be left clean and free of litter at the end of event, do not leave unsold or unwanted items, they must go with you.

All items are to be confined within the boundary lines to prevent injuries and to facilitate foot traffic. If the vehicle area of the stall is utilized for display and/or sales, the vehicle must be moved to a parking lot of the Market.

Organizations must occupy stall(s) by 4:30 pm, and **stay for the entirety of the event.** Due to traffic and event attendees, participating organization's vehicles will not be permitted to exit the event early.

Treats offered must be pre-packaged; whole fruits such as apples can be offered. Home-made treats such as baked goods made in your own kitchen (rather than in a commercial kitchen by certified food handlers) are not allowed! If you are not sure if the treats you have in mind are OK, please contact the Market Office at 585-428-6907 to check.
