- Removing hazardous contamination from a longabandoned and blighted oil refinery site
- Restoring flood protection to the Plymouth-Exchange (PLEX) neighborhood
- Fostering economic opportunity by preparing properties for redevelopment
- Constructing trails and other amenities to reconnect PLEX and the broader community with the riverfront



- Trail closures and detours




