

Improve the condition of traffic control devices




#### Five alternatives investigated


- 1) In Street Bicycle Lane from Elmwood to Bellevue (10/20/2020 concept)
- 2) One-Way Cycle Track: Elmwood to Bellevue (bicycles on both sides)
- 3) Two-Way Cycle Track: Elmwood to Bellevue (bicycles on east side only)
- 4) Two-Way Cycle Track modified
  - Elmwood to Bellevue (bicycles on east side only & maintains trail)
- 5) Hybrid Cycle Track \*
  - In street from Elmwood to Highland (#1)
  - One-way cycle track Highland to Bellevue (#2)

#### **Challenges / considerations**

- Tree removals
- Driveway and Street crossings
- Utility impacts both public and private
- Cost
- Miscellaneous considerations: Highland Trail project









#### **Intersection Options – Reservoir Avenue**









- Intersection skew















## **Safety: Intersections and Crossings**



The intersection of South and Reservoir Avenues would be modified to create offset intersections.

#### Reason for recommendation:

- ✓ Eliminates undesirable skew angle
- ✓ Easier navigation through intersection
- ✓ Shortens pedestrian crossing distances for both the east and west legs





## **Location of Parking / Parking Impacts**



#### **Parking Assessment**

- City of Rochester municipal code states "A vehicle must park within 12" of curb"
- Parking to be removed: Elmwood Avenue to Gold Street on west side
- All other parking to remain on South Avenue
