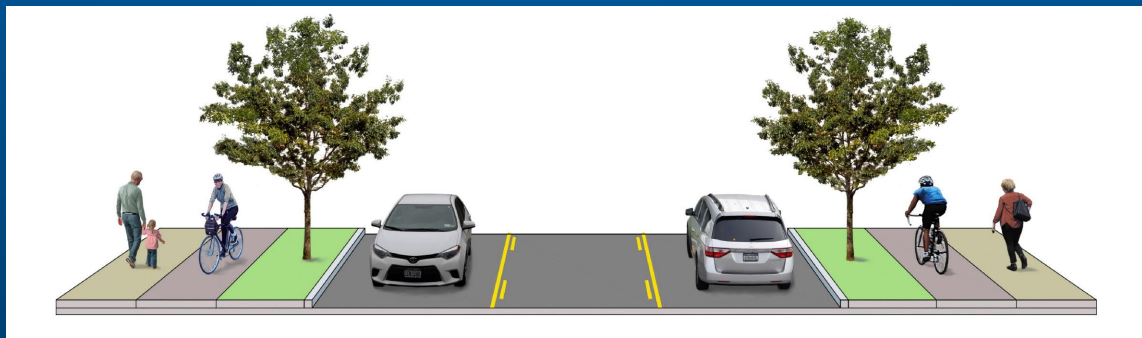
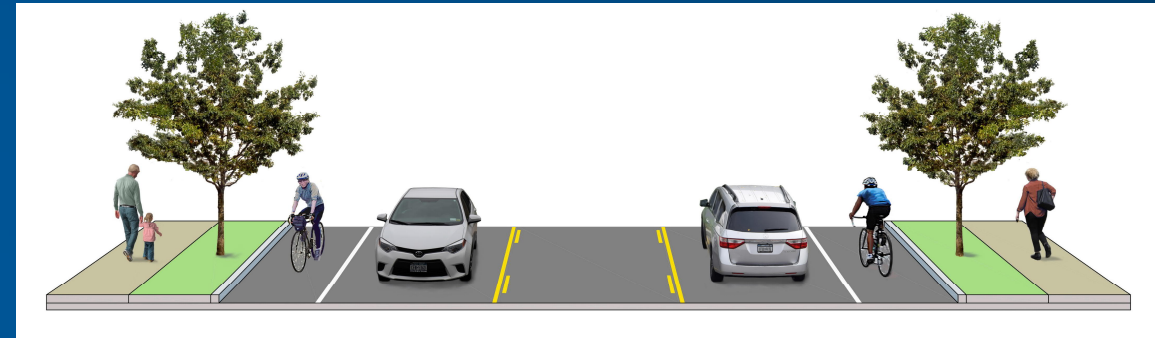
**A** Two-Way Cycle Track

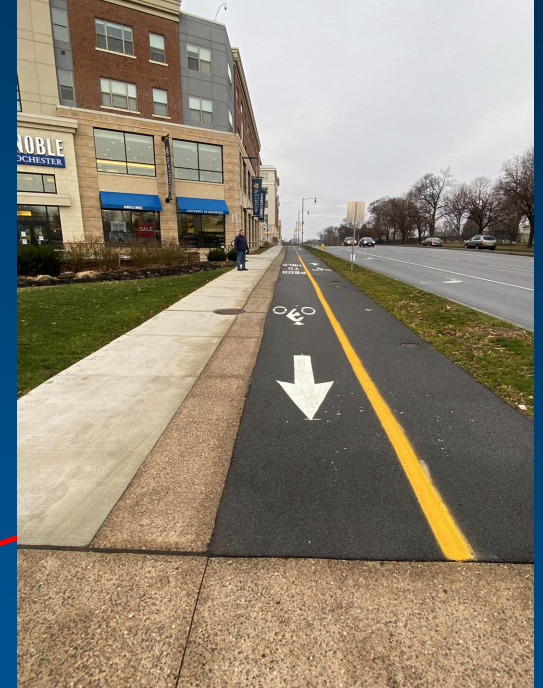

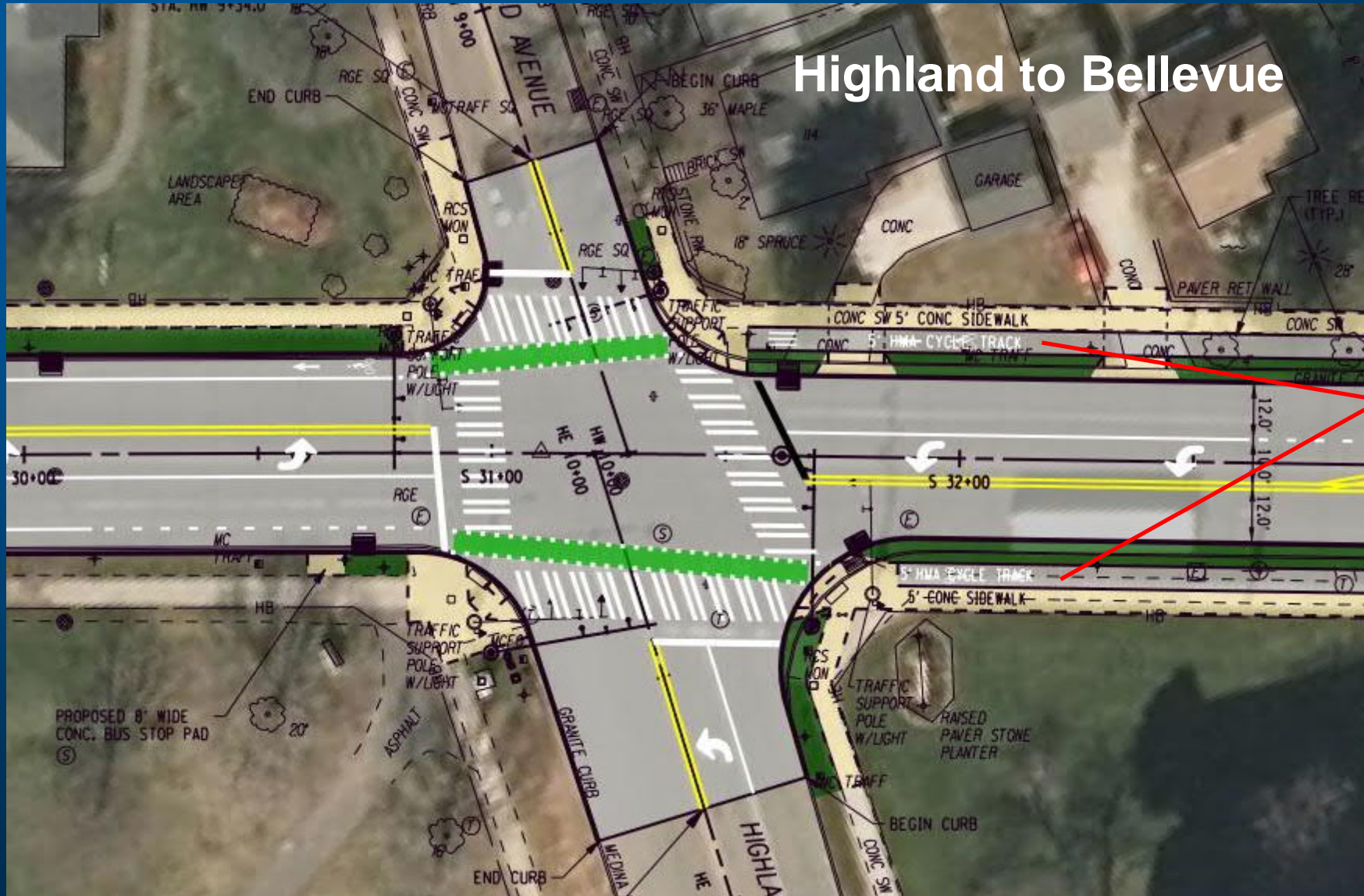

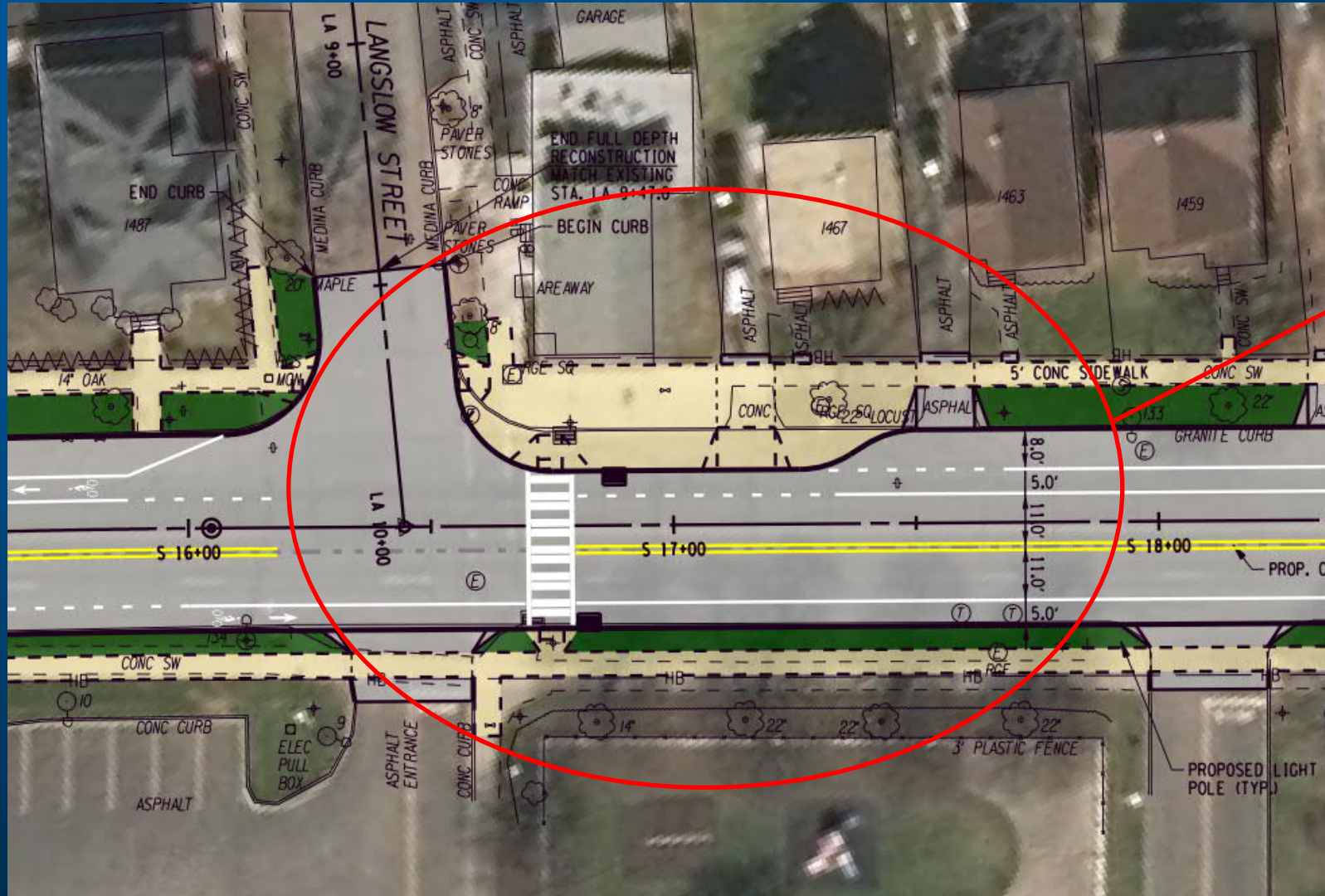

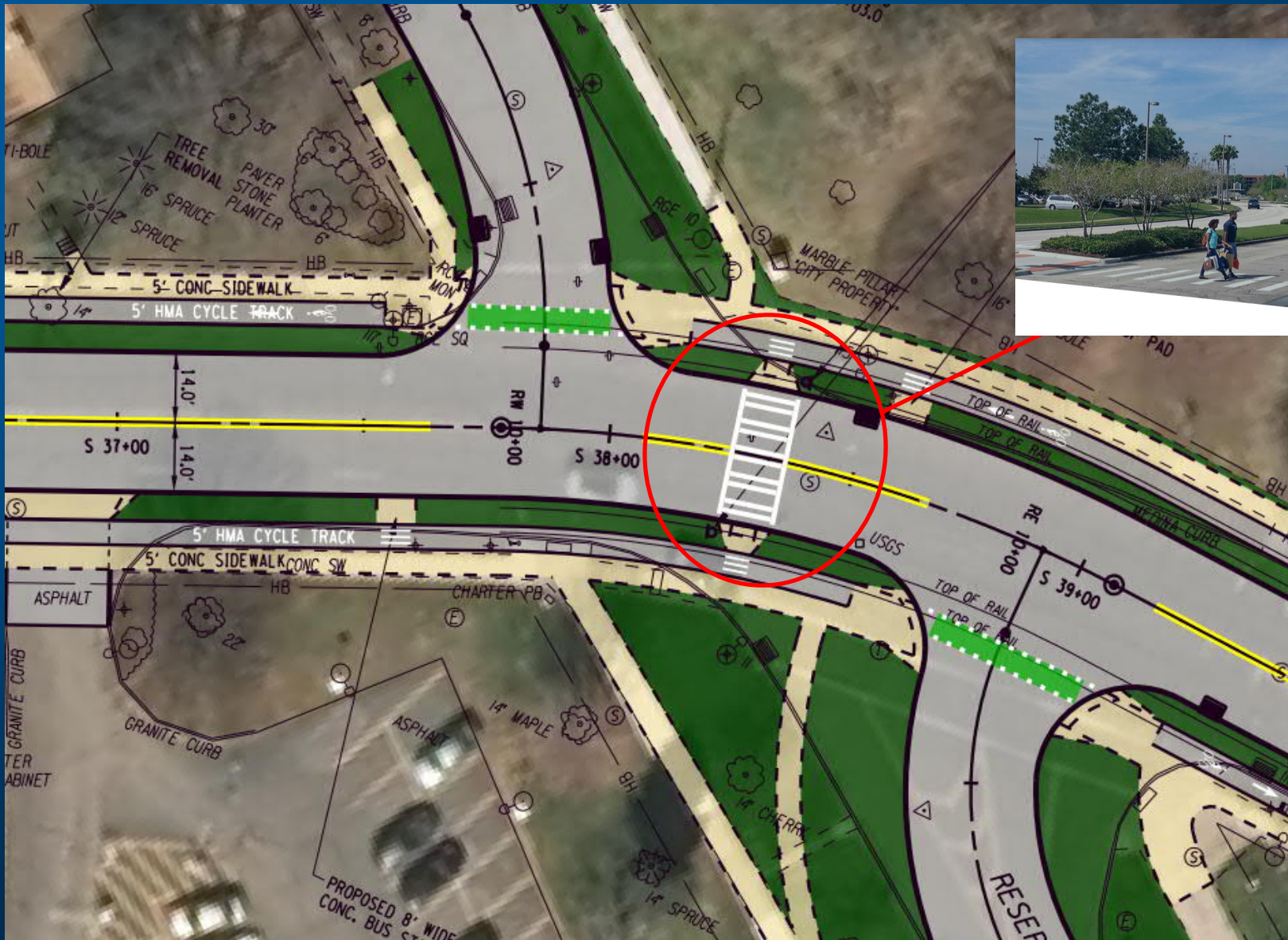

Increase visibility and improve driver yield rates at crosswalks with high-intensity flashing LED light bars.

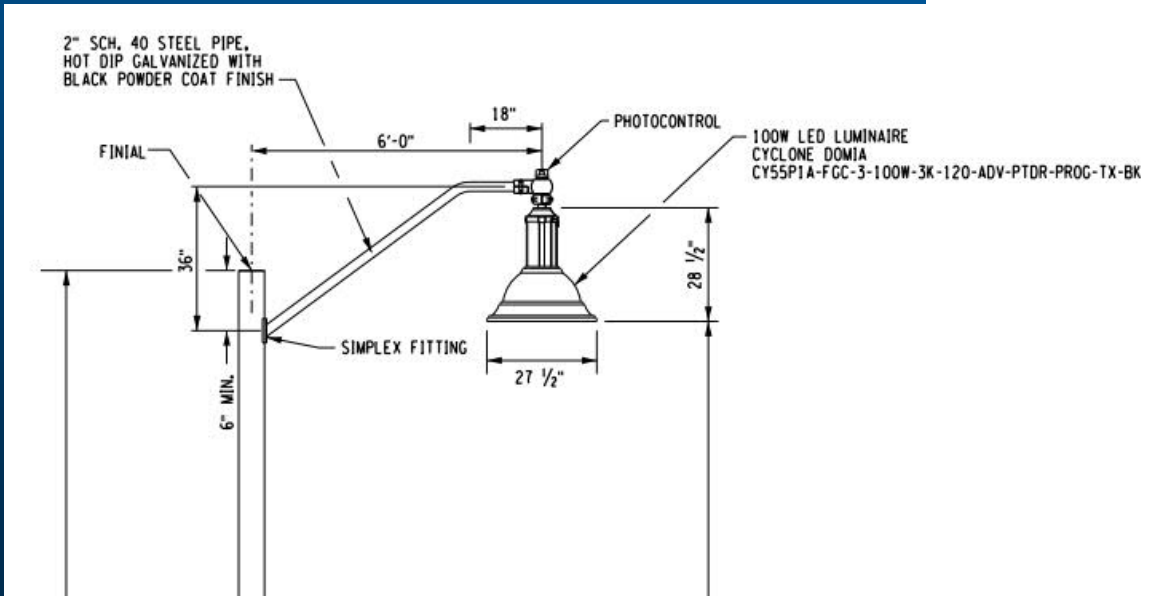
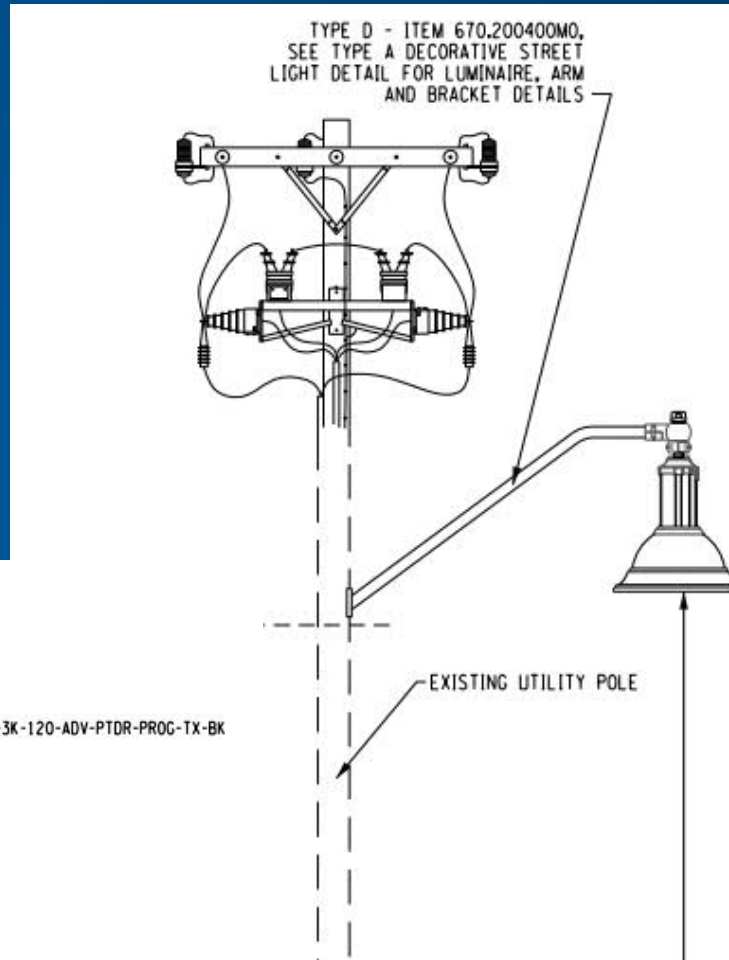
