



Eligibility for a Master Plumbing License

To be eligible for a plumbing license, you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- A. Completion of an apprenticeship through a state or federally approved plumbing, heating or air-conditioning apprenticeship program, plus at least two (2) additional years working in the plumbing, heating, or air- conditioning business;
- B. Eight (8) years of experience in one or more of the following occupations, plumbing; steam fitting; plumbing design; heating or air-conditioning; plumbing or heating or air conditioning estimating; or
- C. Possess a current New York State license as a professional engineer or registered architect; or
- D. Ten years' experience as a maintenance person working at plumbing, heating, air-conditioning or refrigeration trades; or
- E. Any equivalent combination of training and experience, as approved by the Examining Board of Plumbers.

You may choose to provide attachments such as a resume, reference letter, inspection certificates, diplomas, etc. These documents are not required for a complete application, although the Board may request to review them at any time.
