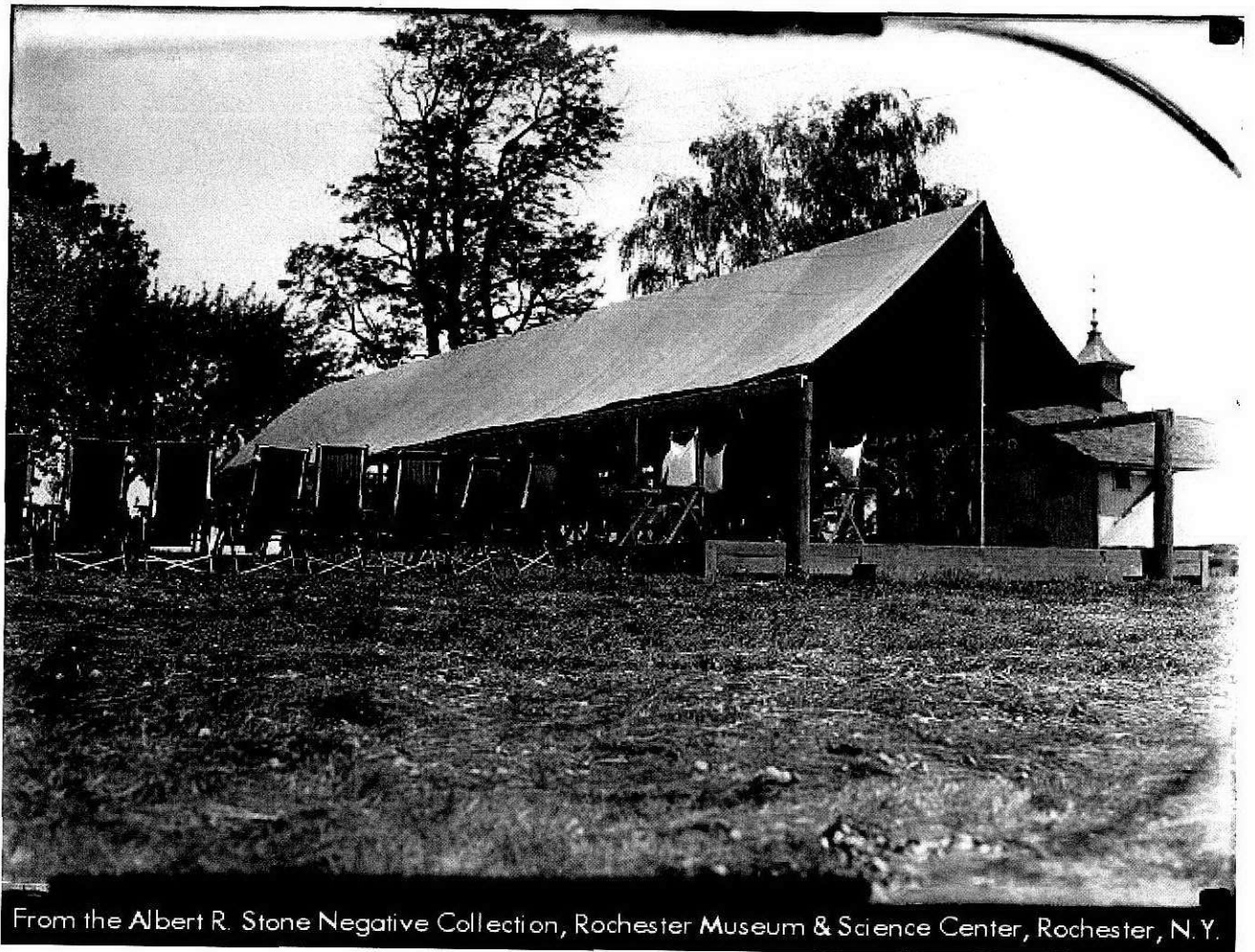




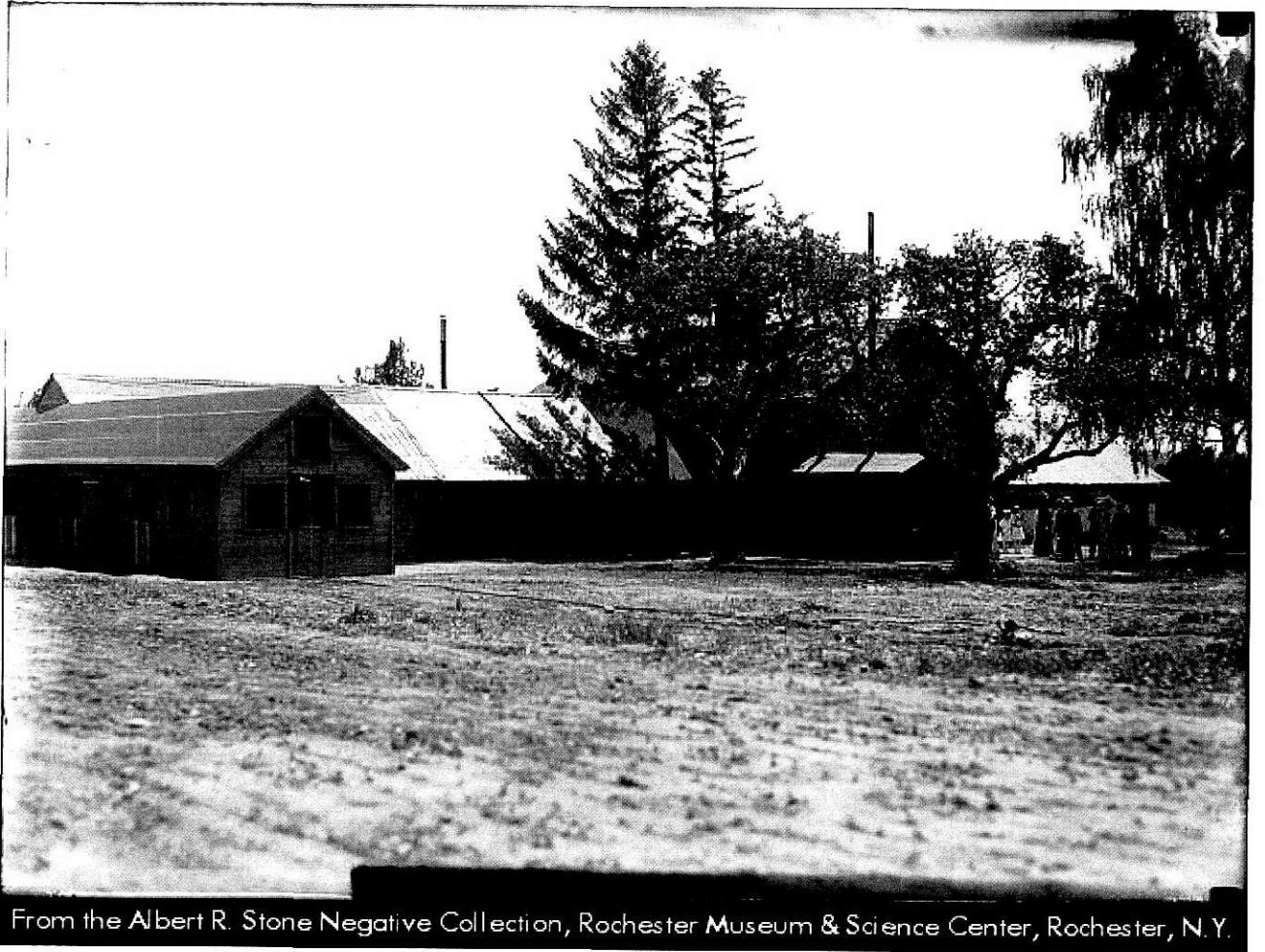

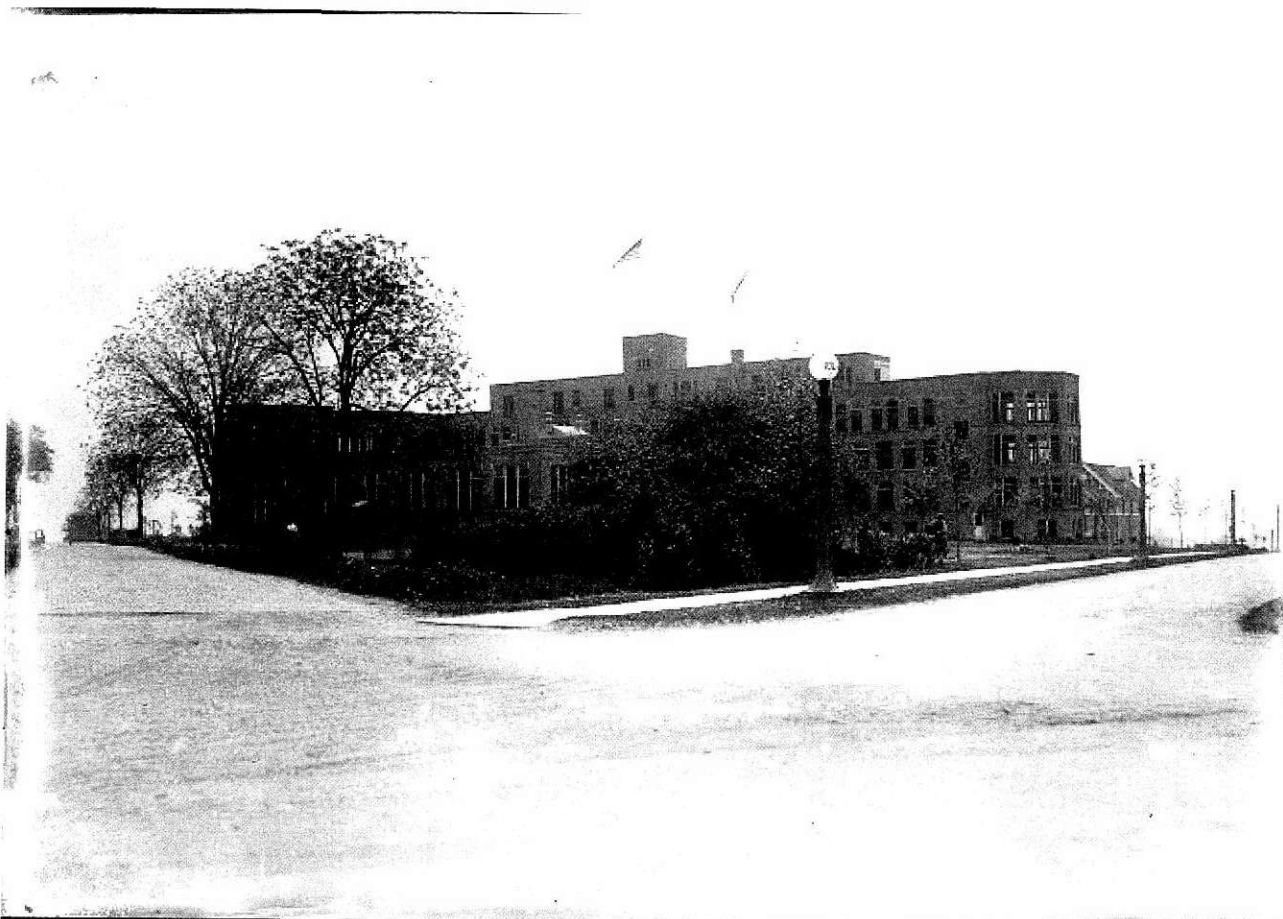

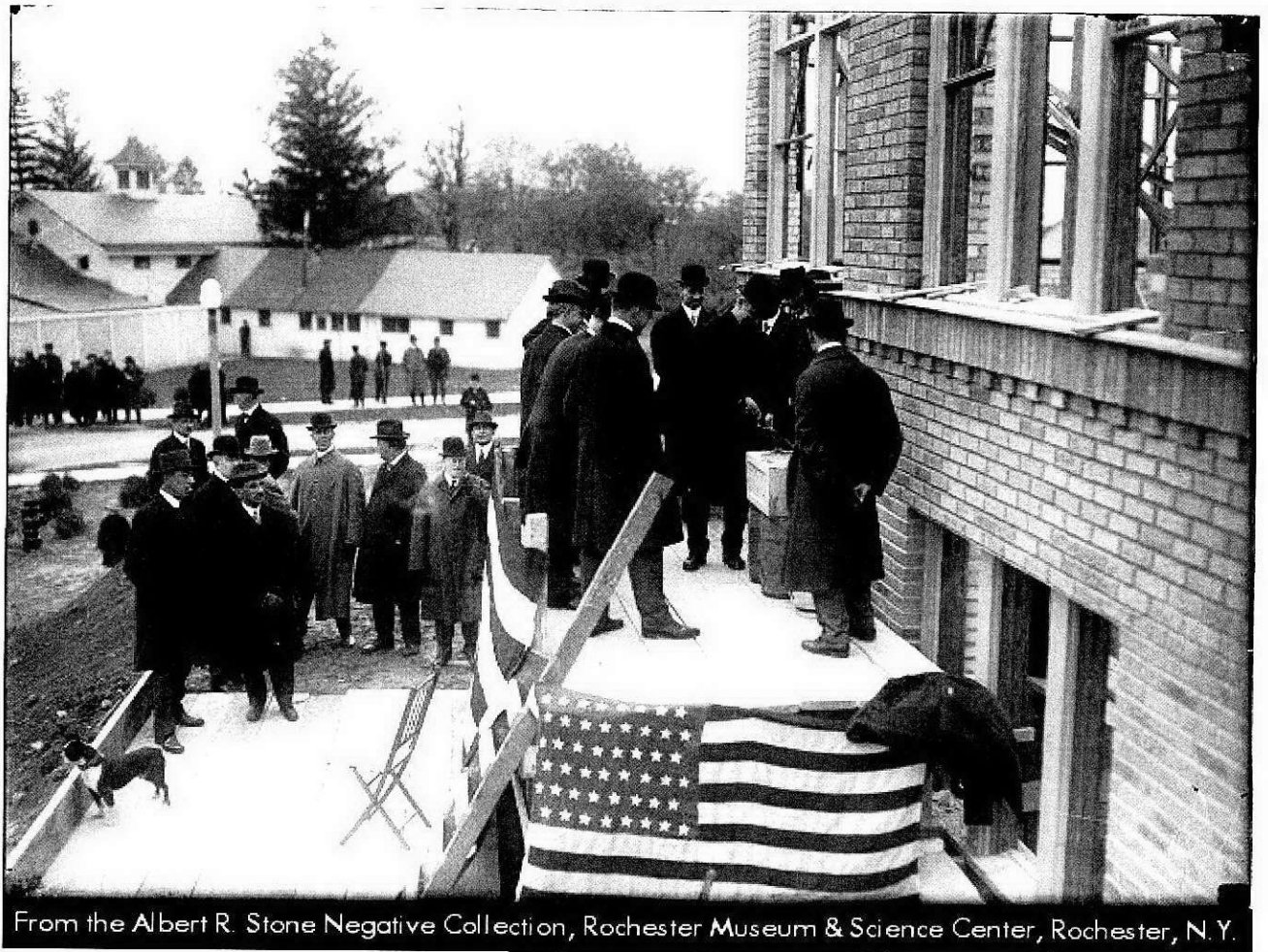

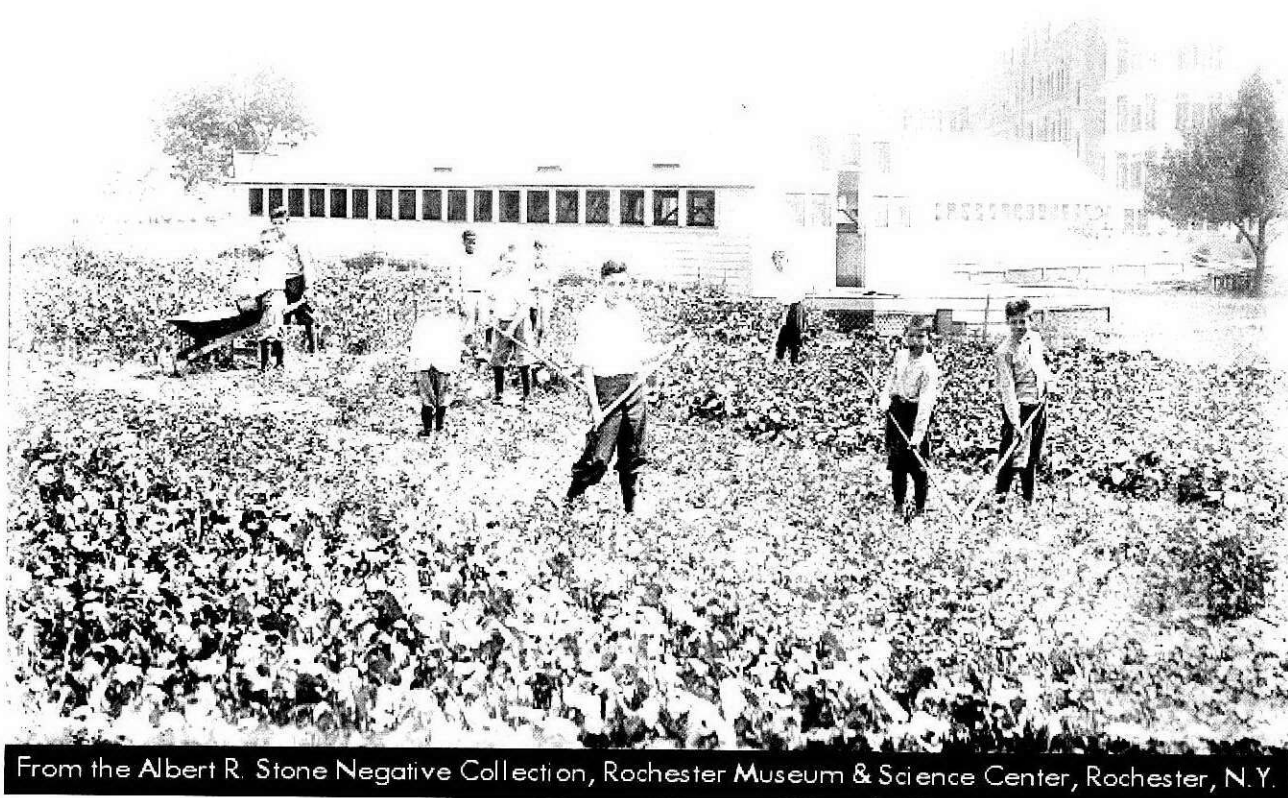

- Notes** Printed in Rochester Herald, July 12, 1916. Reprinted in Rochester Herald, January 28, 1923.

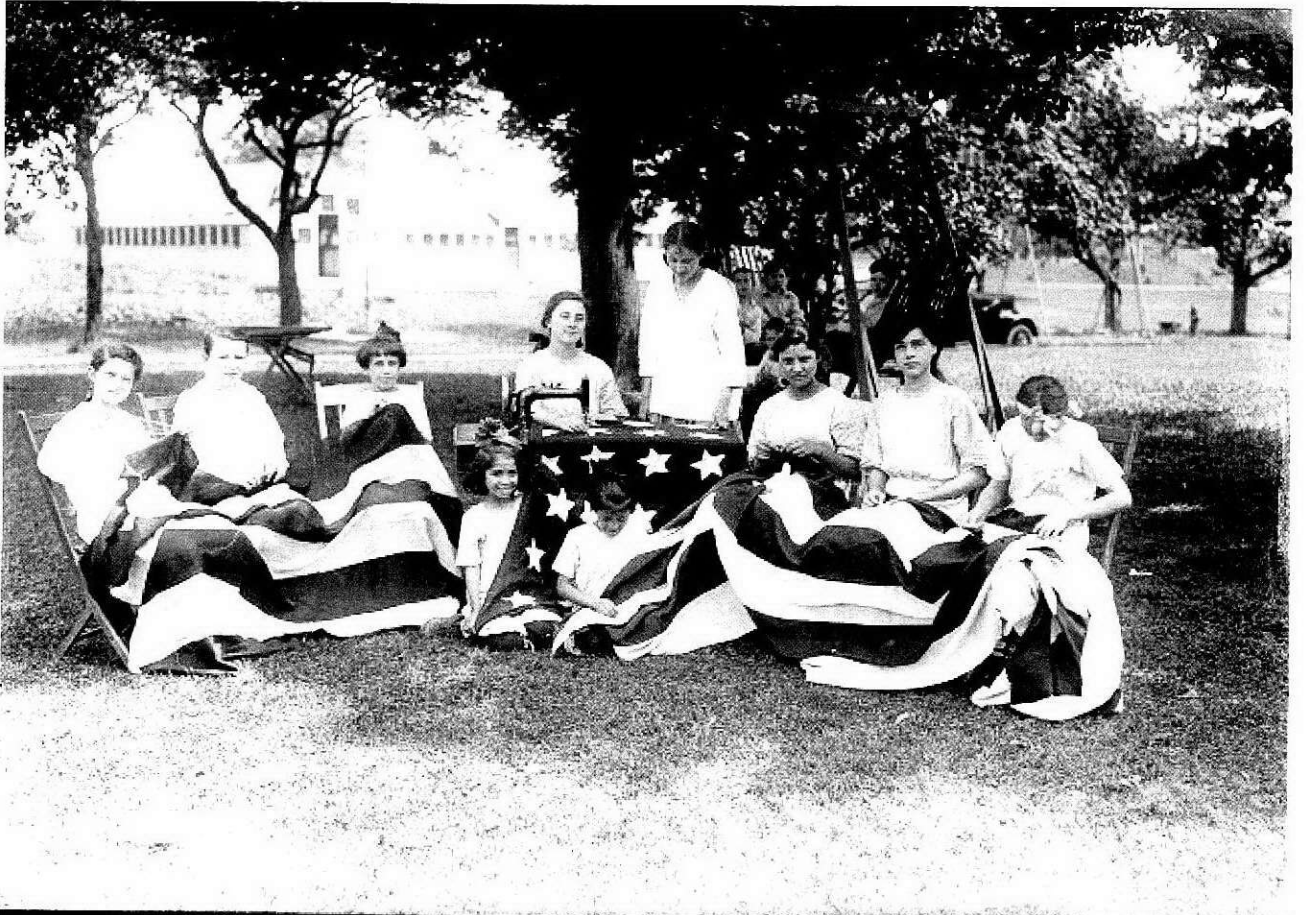
