

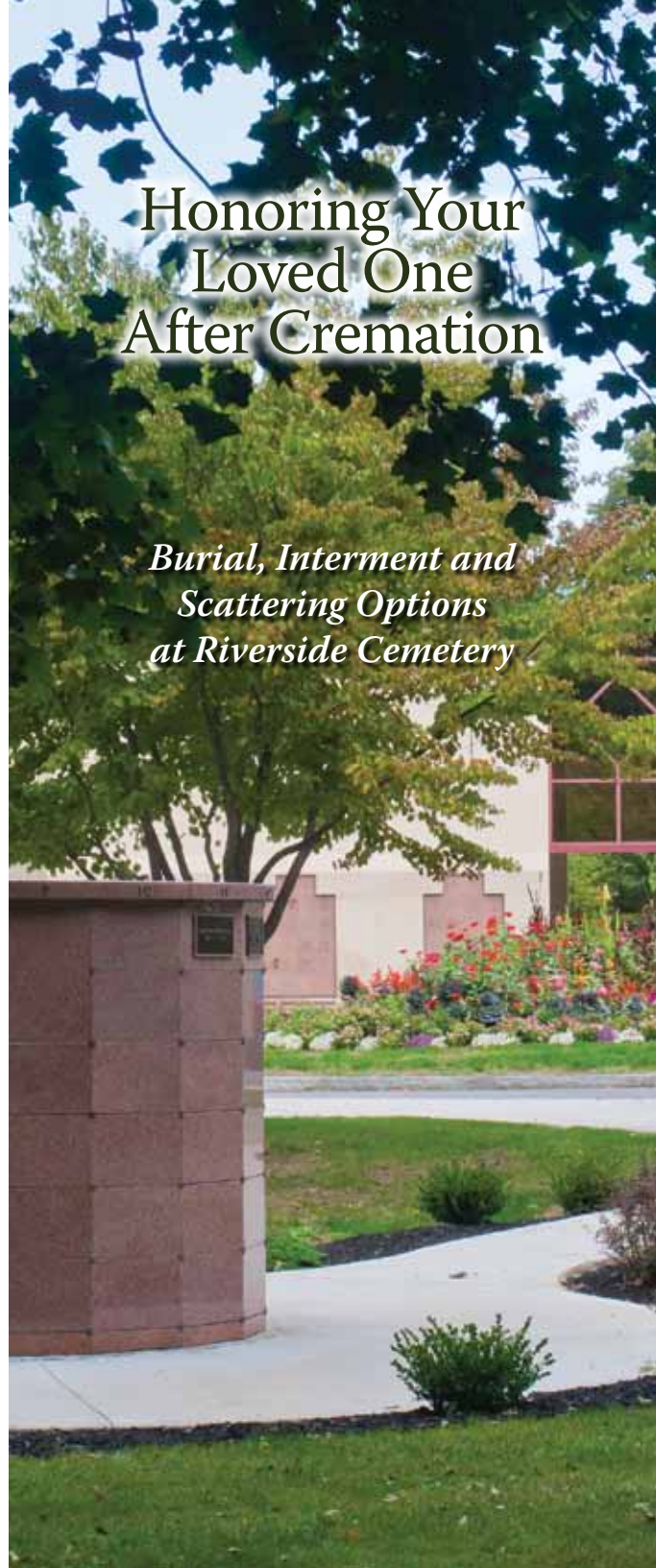

Choose Riverside Cemetery to Honor Your Loved One After Cremation



Many families choose to place their loved one's cremated remains in a permanent site, such as a cemetery. At Riverside we offer many options including burial in the ground, placement in a columbarium or mausoleum niche, or scattering of the cremated remains in a designated garden.

A committal service can accompany the placement of the cremated remains in the final resting place. A large, non-denominational chapel is available onsite for committal services.

Ground Burial

Grave space specifically sized for the burial of cremated remains is available in several locations of the cemetery, including the veterans' section. The choice to use a traditional grave space solely for cremation interments is also permitted. In these instances, three cremated remains may be buried in one space. Two cremation burials are also permitted above a traditional casket burial. An additional right of interment fee is assessed for the second and third burials in a grave space.

Chapel of Peace Mausoleum

Interior and exterior niche options are available within the Chapel of Peace Mausoleum. Interior niches are offered with either clear glass fronts for displaying decorative urns or with traditional marble fronts. Exterior granite fronted niche spaces are set within unique and intimate courtyard environments.

Circle of Peace Columbarium

The Circle of Peace columbarium is nestled in a courtyard between mausoleum buildings. The location affords a view of a landscaped area and the tranquility of a neighboring cemetery, and is handicap accessible. One or two urns may be placed within each niche space, dependent on urn size. A classic bronze plaque on the niche front memorializes the name, and birth and death years of a loved one. A sculpture depicting flying doves is scheduled to be installed on top of the columbarium in spring 2013.



Willow Pond Columbaria

The site of the Willow Pond community columbarium affords bench seating for visitation and handicap accessibility. The location offers a view of the pond and the tranquil sounds from a nearby fountain. One or two urns may be placed within each niche space, dependent on size. The niche front affords the ability to engrave the name, and birth and death years of a loved one along with etchings or emblems. In addition to the community columbaria, private cremation bench estates front the pond from across the way.

Path of Peace

The Path of Peace offers sites for the placement of private columbaria. The natural pathway affords a highly landscaped area with close proximity to Willow Pond.

Garden of Remembrance

The Garden of Remembrance affords the ability to inter a loved one's cremated remains in a wooded area situated adjacent to the Circle of Peace columbarium. Natural boulders are provided within the garden for memorial inscriptions.

Private Estate Columbaria

Locations for the placement of a columbarium in a family lot are available throughout the cemetery. Columbaria may be personalized in design and accommodate as many family members as desired. A columbarium may be purchased from Riverside or a third party at the discretion of the purchaser and approval of the cemetery. The land is purchased from the cemetery before installation of the columbarium.

The Walk of Peace Scattering Garden

The Walk of Peace provides a tranquil location to scatter cremated remains. The garden overlooks the natural beauty of a wetland area that is home to diverse wildlife. A monument at the site affords the ability to memorialize loved ones. Scattering occurs in a patch of wildflowers located behind the monument. A nominal recording fee is all that is required to perform a scattering. An additional fee is charged to install a bronze marker on the monument with an individual's name, and birth and death years.
